Helpful Hints For Letters Of Support

Some relevant topics that have an impact on charter school discussions are as follows:

MCA will offer a more traditional school setting; content-rich, directed curriculum; limiting technical devices (cell phones, iPads, etc.) in classrooms; desire for better discipline and fewer distractions in classrooms; seeking a 'core knowledge' approach to teaching; providing a foundation of virtue and self-reliance; etc. Personal experiences or reliable anecdotal information can also be very useful in letters. There are some people who also feel a classical charter public school might be an added incentive for families considering a move to the Montrose area.

Some ideas for content:

By offering a traditional, liberal arts curriculum, Montrose Classical Academy will provide students with the basic classical academic knowledge as well as a deep appreciation and understanding of the American culture and heritage.

Families are interested in this school choice for a variety of reasons, including the fact that not all children learn in the same way. Different approaches can better serve different children. Having a variety of educational options is essential for our students and their families. This is an additional opportunity to provide a solid foundation for our future successful, self-reliant citizens.

The curriculum Montrose Classical Academy will offer provides students with strong reading (phonics) and writing skills, mathematics, classical and other great literature, American and world history, cursive writing, Latin, and technology. This school will seek to minimize distractions in a variety of ways, including requiring uniforms and not allowing electronic devices in grammar school classrooms.

Personal experiences or reliable anecdotal information can also be very useful.

Some people in Montrose have expressed the feeling that having this type of educational opportunity might be a positive factor when families are evaluating a move to this area.
